GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

1. The Con Englehorn Educational Scholarship has been established for promising young students, recent college graduates, or individuals with an interest in pursuing a career in real estate appraising.
2. Our goal is to support recipients interested in developing a career in the rural appraisal industry with up to \$2,000 for training in the rural appraisal courses, college courses, and trade programs associated with agriculture and livestock programs.
3. Applicants must complete the entire application form along with two recommendations from non-relatives. Applications should be typed or computer-generated by the applicant.

5. Recipients of the Con Englehorn Educational Scholarship will be selected based on application, recommendations, and an oral interview with the scholarship committee.
6. Leadership qualities such as 4H, FFA, church, clubs, student government, and civic organization participation will be considered.
7. Personality, ability to communicate, and interpersonal skills are considerations. A personal interview will be conducted for applicants.
8. Commitment to the appraisal industry and financial need will be considered.
9. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all information arrives by the deadline. Please note, it is recommended that the applicant's references be contacted and reminded of the deadline.
10. The application deadline is December 1. Applications must be emailed by this date to qualify for consideration.



11. Scholarships will be awarded the following February.
